

What we do

Ascot Volunteer Bureau is a local charity, providing transport for the older residents of Ascot, Sunningdale and Sunninghill who have difficulty getting to their medical appointments at, for example, hospitals, surgeries, dentists and opticians.

We take people to appointments within the immediate area and also further afield.

We are staffed completely by volunteers.

What we need

We are always looking for volunteers who wish to drive and/or action and manage requests for transport.

Drivers

Our drivers give as much or as little time as they wish, only accepting jobs which are convenient for them.

They need to have a full driving licence, their own car and Third-Party car insurance.

Our clients pay the driver a contribution towards the running cost of his/her car. This is currently 50p per mile or a minimum £5 flat rate for local journeys.

Office Workers

The volunteers pick up messages from clients requiring transport. Each call is logged and drivers contacted to find someone able to do the job.

Ideally volunteers for this work need to be available for one morning each week.

All applicants must undergo a DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check before commencing as a volunteer

How we are funded

We are a non-profit organisation and are dependent on grants and donations to cover our administration costs — office rental, telephone, postage, and other incidental costs.

We have been fortunate in receiving funding from a number of sources over the years but are always looking for new ways to fund the organisation.
